DAY 1 WINDHOEK - KALAHARI DESERT: After a city tour of Windhoek, travel south over Namibia's second highest mountain range to the edge of the Kalahari Desert. Remainder of the day is at leisure. Overnight Kalahari Desert.

DAY 2 KALAHARI DESERT: Morning walk (unguided, for own account) or relax at the pool. Enjoy a sundowner drive in the red dunes of the Kalahari. Overnight Kalahari Desert. [BD]

DAY 3 KALAHARI - FISH RIVER CANYON: Travel to the Fish River Canyon in the heart of the Nama Karoo. Undertake a sundowner mountain walk. Overnight Fish River Canyon. [BD]

DAY 4 NAMA KAROO DESERT: Visit the rim of the Fish River Canyon and join a nature drive to observe the fragile plants and wildlife of the Nama Karoo. Overnight Fish River Canyon. [BD]
